This interactive session at SUCOMINNO II will combine innovation, teamwork, and problem-solving, culminating in a Cooking Day, where participants will test their creations by preparing food using only the sun's energy. A unique opportunity to develop soft skills while embracing sustainability!	Cooked Oil to Biodiesel & Microplastics – Workshops by AKTI Organisation As part of SUCOMINNO II, AKTI Organisation will deliver two impactful workshops on sustainability and marine conservation. The Tiganokinisi Caravan will introduce participants to the process of transforming used cooking oil into biodiesel, promoting renewable energy and circular economy practices. In the Microplastics in the Sea workshop, participants will analyze water samples to identify microplastics, understand their impact on marine ecosystems, and explore solutions for reducing pollution. These hands-on sessions aim to raise awareness, encourage responsible environmental action, and inspire innovative solutions. Hiking & Environmental Discussion – Exploring Pissouri's Natural Beauty Start the day with a scenic hike from Dogs Beach, discovering Pissouri's coastal landscapes and biodiversity through interactive tasks along the way. This immersive experience will be followed by a discussion with the Environmental Team of Pissouri Community Council, focusing on local conservation efforts, sustainability initiatives, and community-driven environmental actions. A perfect blend of exploration, learning, and environmental awareness! –	Adopt-a-Beach – Workshop with Aggelos Pechlivanis At SUCOMINNO II, Aggelos Pechlivanis will introduce the Adopt-a-Beach program, a citizen science initiative for monitoring and combating marine pollution across Cyprus. The Epitaphios , adorned with flowers, is carried through the streets by clergy and parishioners, accompanied by candlelight, hymns, and prayers. The scent of incense fills the air as believers pass under it for blessing. This solemn tradition unites the community in faith and devotion, leading to the anticipation of Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday . 23.00: Way back to the venue
